Community Choice Aggregation Defined

- "Allows local governments to aggregate their electricity load in order to purchase and/or develop power projects on behalf of their residents, businesses, and municipal accounts."
- "Works in partnership with the region's existing utility, which continues to deliver power, maintain the grid, provide consolidated billing and other customer services."




CCA load could potentially account for 80% of IOU customer procurement

CCA Landscape

- 19 CCAs
- Serve 10 million customers (or 4 million accounts)
- 94% customer participate rate
- 43% of load is RPS eligible
